Summary:

The second meeting of the Non-Commercial Operations with Complex Motor-Powered Aircraft Sub-Group focused on a review of the draft transposition of JAR OPS 2 into EASA OPS 2 that Ray Rohr and the EASA Secretariat had prepared and the identification of issues that would require further work. The Sub-Group also reviewed and accepted the [Work Plan](#) that had been prepared prior to the meeting. A copy of the [draft meeting minutes](#) are linked to this report.

1. DDE opened the meeting and welcomed all participants. She informed the group on the apologies received from RRO. She brought forward the request from Mario Moura, Chairman of the OPS.001 core group, to JTP to act as interim chairman for this meeting. JTP accepted the request. He asked all participants to present themselves as there were new group participants.

2. The agenda was changed as follows:

1. Adoption of Agenda
2. Review of minutes of 9 November 2006 meeting
3. Review of Transposition of JAR OPS 2
4. Review of Work Plan
5. Identification of Issues, Work to be done and coordination required with other Sub-Groups and Groups
6. AOB

The presentation from RRO on IS-BAO had been postponed to the next meeting in December.

3. The group had a conference call with RRO to exchange information and discuss the work for the next two days. The following issues were discussed:

- RRO to distribute copy of ICAO Annex 6 Part II proposal. ICAO is expected to publish this proposal as State Letter by the end of November.
- In addition to IS-BAO other industry standards in this field. DCA asked DDE to put the NBAA (National Business Aviation Association of the US) Management Guide on circa. It includes a series of good practices.
- The positive accident record of non-commercial operations with complex motor-powered aircraft. The group agreed to take this into account when developing Part OPS 2. It was emphasised that the regulation needs to be appropriate to the size and scale of operation.

4. The group adopted the full group meeting minutes from the 9 November morning meeting without changes. The subgroup meeting minutes from the 9 November afternoon meeting were adopted without changes.

5. The group discussed fractional ownership aspects and considered a separate subpart with additional requirements for fractional ownership operations. DCA offered a presentation on FAR 91K and on the discussions when drafting the proposal of ICAO Annex 6 II regarding fractional ownership for the January meeting. DCA briefly explained the structure of FAR 91: FAR 91 is the general operating rule, FAR 91 Subpart F applies to complex aircraft and FAR 91 Subpart K to fractional ownership.

6. DDE gave a short briefing on industry standards mentioning the EU New and Global Approach (new approach to product regulation and global approach to conformity assessment) and the use of standards in EASA regulatory activities.

7. The group reviewed Chapter 8 of the essential requirements of the Commission proposal to remind itself of the provisions to be taken into account for the implementing rule. The applicable implementing rules for paragraph 8.d. security programme may need to be subject to a RIA as group discussions showed some uncertainty on the level of detail.

8. The group reviewed the working paper ver. 1.1 that included draft JAR-OPS 2 and its explanatory note together with comments and proposals by RRO and DDE for further review, transfer, development or deletion of paragraphs for Part OPS 2. The following issues were discussed in more detail and need to be addressed further:

- MEL: The group discussed the development and approval of a MEL when no MMEL is available. DDE confirmed that in the future every complex motor-powered aircraft will have a MMEL. The issue therefore affects only older aircraft.
- Additional crew members: The group finally stated that the operator decides on who is a crew member. The requirement needs to be drafted.

- Ditching: It is not clear what this paragraph regulates. Needs further review.
- Aircraft Technical Log: Part-M requires a technical log for CAT only. It needs to be checked if the ICAO SARPs require a Tech Log for complex aircraft. The paragraph needs to be reviewed further.
- Leasing: Group members commented that other forms of exchange of aircraft should also be considered. Otherwise the paragraph may be deleted. Needs further review.
- Declaration: The group touched upon the value of such declaration. It was said that the operator has to comply with the requirements by law anyhow. The group furthermore discussed the need to renew such declaration, the need to carry a copy of the declaration on board an aircraft and the possible content of such declaration. DDE stated that the requirements are linked to certain oversight and should be addressed together with the authority subgroup.
- Approvals for specific operations: DDE was requested to check the ICAO SARPs.
- Mass and Balance: The group questioned the actual weighing interval of 4 years and its application to all aircraft types. It furthermore discussed if the future rule should encompass a generic requirement to establish a system and procedure for the determination of mass or specific requirements on the determination of operating items, crew and fuel load. DDE asked group member to study the impact of the two options in order to come to a conclusion at the next meeting.

9. The following issues were identified for discussion with the authority subgroup:

- Draft JAR-OPS 2 provisions on quality assurance programme, accident prevention and flight safety programme and the new concept of SMS;
- Power to inspect and implications from the new Art. 7 of the Basic Regulation;
- Extent and content of the Declaration.

10. The following issues will be put forward to the core group for consideration and coordination:

- Paragraph on applicability within the Part;
- Duplication of requirements in the essential requirements and implementing rules. DDE explained that implementing rules (IR) specify the essential requirements (ER) in setting standards on how to comply with them. ER are therefore not repeated in the IR. Group members expressed the view that the requirements should be in one "book" for ease of reference.

11. For the next meeting, the group decided to review JAR-OPS 1 Subparts to identify subsequent changes that may need to be considered for Part OPS 2. The task was shared as follows:

- Subparts B, D - GPA
- Subparts K, L - DCA
- Subparts M, P, S - DDE
- Subpart N - JTP

- Subpart O of JAR-OPS 1 and EU-OPS - JMA
